Maria is a truly diverse creative professional and a natural leader, coming from a dynasty of architects, artists, industrialists, educators, diplomats, writers and received a traditional European home education (and later formal schooling) which included horseback riding, ballet and music lessons. Designer Architect, Project Manager, Artist and Consultant with a lifetime experience in creative solutions in art and design and is known for her attention to detail, integrity, working on every project with equal focus and care regardless of the project size or budget.

Maria started her career with an architectural internship at the Leningrad Institute of Scientific Research and Experimental Building in Various Climate Zones (St. Petersburg, Russia) and as an Assistant Designer at a Japanese-Russian joint venture "Likoraduga" assisting in designing yachts and yacht clubs. She was also involved in designing International Trade Shows and Exhibitions. Later, Maria's impeccable sense of design and love for history brought her projects in renovation and restoration of historical buildings in New England, including religious and residential buildings.

After moving to Washington, DC and working as a Principal Interior Designer position at Chevy Chase Design Center, leading the Design Department, Maria was invited to join TransitLabs LLC to design a private meeting space for UN officials in New York City and later to lead a project in Africa, Ivory Coast, Abidjan where she designed and managed a traffic control center building working with a local crew and PM cabinet officials.

Maria was always interested in eco-friendly methods of building and creating healthy spaces for people, using non-toxic, natural and sustainable materials but after working in Africa and seeing ecological disasters close in person she completely focused on Eco architecture and design, conducting research and implementing best known practices in her projects.

Since 2019 Maria has been working with a group of inventors on sustainable and healthy methods of building and growing food, also having her inventions patented in the USA and worldwide. Maria is a co-founder of Dream Habitat LLC managing research and applications in the building department.

Maria's interest in innovation and management brought her to the Disaster Relief sector, currently she is on the Board of Directors at STORM LLC.

As an artist Maria is working in different styles and media, constantly exploring new ways of expression, from scientific botanical art and illustration to free-flowing painting on silk, from impressionistic paintings to abstract art, to color consulting and interior design. One can find a lot of symbolism and philosophical thought as well as a range of emotions and overwhelming sense of beauty in Maria's art, whether it's a landscape, stillife, figurative or abstract painting.

In 2015 Maria took interest in Neuroscience, which is lasting till present, doing research in brain studies related to color theory and practical applications. She is developing a course combining the latest scientific studies and art, designed to aid personal development and healing.

She is also a member of an American Society of Botanical Artists where her interest in nature and art combined and flourished into a number of botanical artworks which were exhibited all over the USA.

Maria's professional training began in 1986 in private schools and studios of leading artists in Russia, professors D. Shuvalov, E. Troitskij and R. Kurilyak. She also took a two-year prep. course at the Baron Stieglitz State Academy of Art and Design.

1990-1996 studied for the MFA at the Baron Stieglitz State Academy of Art and Design, St. Petersburg, Russia, a historical art school, one of the best in Europe, formed in 19 century during the Industrial Revolution, along with a few others in Europe, to become one of the first design schools in history. It started by preparing masters to work for FABERGE and later embraced and developed BAUHAUS ideas and aesthetics in design.

Maria took a program which included architecture, design, painting, drawing, color theory, anatomy, interior design, composition, art history, philosophy, sociology, ergonomics, economics, and much more.

During her student years Maria's works were selected for a number of "Best of School" exhibits and after moving to the USA Maria has been participating in art shows and competitions all over the world.

In 2003 Maria was invited to participate at an important International art show in Florence, Italy, Biennale of Contemporary Art where among 900 competing artists from 72 countries she was recognized as one of the Best Artists and received a Lorenzo (the Magnificent) Medici Medal for her paintings.
